

ORDINANCE 2016-6-1

The Town Board of the Town of Dane, Dane County, Wisconsin, does hereby ordain as follows:

That, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 60.30(1e)(a), the office of the Clerk shall be filled by appointment of a majority of the members-elect of the Town Board.

The term of office for the appointed position shall be set by the Town Board, but may not exceed three(3) years per § 60.30(1e)(c). The Town Board may re-appoint the Clerk for additional terms. However, removal by the Town Board during a given term of office may only be for "cause" as defined under § 17.001 and required by § 60.3(1e)(f).

The ordinance is subject for approval by the town electors in a referendum, which is hereby called by the Town Board to be held on November 8, 2016. The referendum question shall be:


"Shall the person holding the office of Clerk in the Town of Dane be appointed by the Town Board?"

The salary of the appointed position shall be set by the Town Board and may not be reduced during the term of office.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its Town Board passage, notice after passage per § 60.80(1e)(b) and also a referendum approval by the town electors as required by § 60.30(1e)(b).


