

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF DANE TO EXCEED THE STATUTORY LEVY LIMIT FOR SPECIFIC PURPOSES

WHEREAS, pursuant to Wisconsin Statutes, the Town of Dane is subject to a limit on the amount of property tax levy which may be assessed;

WHEREAS, the levy limit is based on the amount of tax revenue which the Town has raised historically, which has been low by comparison to other Towns;

WHEREAS, the expense of replacing road maintenance equipments which has been deferred and must be taken care of;


WHEREAS, under section 66.0602 (5), Wis. Stats., town with a population of less than 3000 may exceed the levy limit if the Town Board adopts a Resolution supporting an increase, and the Resolution is adopted by a majority of the electors voting at the Special Meeting of the electors of the Town;

WHEREAS, the Town Board has adopted this Resolution and placed it on the agenda of the 2016 Budget Public Hearing of the Town;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BUDGET PUBLIC HEARING OF THE TOWN OF DANE, that the Town of Dane hereby authorized to exceed the statutory levy limit by \$200,000 dollars for the tax levy of 2017, to be collected over 5 subsequent tax years starting in 2018.


